We formally invite your National Darts Body to determine your qualifying players to participate in the appropriate Championships listed above subject to their compliance with the Eligibility Requirements set out below:

## **ELIGIBILITY**

### Eligibility for Participation

In order to participate in the World Masters Championship Finals a player;

a. Must be a member of the BDO or another member darts body of the World Darts Federation

(Lists of which may be found on Page 10 of this document]

b. Must not be serving a period of ineligibility imposed by the BDO, the World Darts Federation or any member darts body of the World Darts Federation

c. Must not be a registered holder of a currently valid Professional Darts Corporation [PDC] Tour card

d. Must not have participated in any PDC Players Championships in the current year

- (i) The player's agreement to be bound by and comply with the following provisions of the BDO Authorised Handbook, copies of which can be found at [www.bdodarts.com](http://www.bdodarts.com) (Under the heading RULES) the Eligibility Rule, the Disciplinary Code, the Anti-Doping Policy, the BDO Playing Rules, including the Player's Dress Code and the Rules/Procedures laid down in the tournament programme.

- (ii) The player's acknowledgement that victory in the Winmau 45th World Masters Men's and Women's Darts Championship will automatically entitle that player to participate in the 2019 BDO World Professional Darts Championship and the player's agreement, in such circumstances, to compete will be signed.
- (iii) The player's agreement that his failure, without satisfactory explanation, to honour the commitment made at clause (ii) above will entitle the BDO to institute disciplinary proceedings against the player under the Disciplinary Code. The player acknowledges that the sanctions available under that Code includes suspension from privileges of membership of the BDO for not more than 18 months from the date of the BDO World Professional Darts Championship in question.
- (iv) Players can only enter via their National Darts Body or BICC Counties.**

**PLAYING FORMAT:-**

**Men's:-** Best of 5 sets, Best of 3 legs per set  
(Quarter Finals + Semi-Finals + Final) To be advised.

**Women's:-** Best of 7 legs, Semi-Final & Final Best of 9 legs

**Youth:-** Best of 7 legs.

All legs 501, Straight start, Finish on a double.  
Knock out basis, one draw only - Bracket system.  
Tie Breaker Rule will only apply to men's final.

**No player can play in both the Youth and Senior event, Under 18's play Youth and over 18's play in the Senior event**

Don't forget that player's under 18 will have to have a jpeg of a parent or guardian. **THIS IS THE ONLY ACCEPTABLE METHOD OF ENTRY**

The seeding of Men's SIXTEEN players and Women's EIGHT players will take place directly we know the up to-date position in the BDO International Rankings Tables

**As at 10th September 2018. The closing date for other qualifiers is 31st August 2018.**

Players are not permitted to wear trousers or skirts made with denim or corduroy material and fashioned in a jean style (patch pockets). This restriction also applies to any form of **Tracksuit or Jeans and shirts should have collars.**

The BDO reserves the right to approve player's attire - BDO Dress code will apply

**Smoking is not permitted throughout the whole venue or the use of electronic cigarettes – No drinks to be consumed during a match or introduced to stage or playing area by any Player/Official.**

**Youth Players:-**

**Drinking of alcohol will not be allowed within the venue during the Youth Championship, also there will be the usual dress code and alcohol testing will take place randomly.**
